Rules and Information

- Applications are open to members of Athboy Credit Union only.
- All applications must be accompanied by a letter of not more than 200 words, as to why you would like to be considered for the bursary. Based on this, candidates may be short listed for interview.
- Proof of acceptance of Third Level Course must be provided. This third level course must be a full-time course, minimum 3 years duration and must be Level 7, Level 8 or higher.
- The Student must be entering college for the first time and going into the 1st year of a third level course. For Mature Students, this must be your first time attending third level education.
- There will be three bursaries of €1,500 each awarded.
- Payment of the bursary is dependent on students producing satisfactory evidence of acceptance of their course.
- The payment will be made directly into the students credit union account.
- Application forms must be returned by Saturday 31st July 2021 to Athboy Credit Union.
- The bursaries will be awarded after a successful interview process.
- The decision of the Board of Directors of Athboy Credit Union shall be final.
- A presentation will be made to the winning students, who will be requested to attend our office for this occasion, adhering to official public health guidance.
